

Call for Expression of Interest for co-financing preparation of feasibility studies and/or PDDs for CDM projects under the bilateral cooperation between the Italian Ministry for the Environment, Land and Sea and the Macedonian Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning

CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

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1. BACKGROUND

Under the Kyoto protocol and based on the "EU Burden- Sharing" Agreement, Italy has committed itself to reduce the emissions of greenhouse gases by 6% during the commitment period 2008-2012 against the base year level.

The Clean Development Mechanism (CDM) is a project-based mechanism under the Kyoto protocol (Article 12). The purpose of the Clean Development Mechanism is to assist Parties not included in Annex I to the UNFCCC in achieving sustainable development and in contributing to the ultimate objective of the UNFCCC, as well as to assist Parties included in Annex I in achieving compliance with their quantified emission limitation and reduction commitments under Article 3 of the Kyoto Protocol.

Republic of Macedonia is a Party to the United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change and has ratified the Kyoto Protocol on 18 November 2004. Furthermore, the Republic of Macedonia is making a significant effort to implement all the crucial changes in the relevant legislation and institutional structure for a full implementation of the Kyoto Protocol through the Clean Development Mechanism.

Considering that the co-operation in the field of the CDM under Article 12 of the Kyoto Protocol will result in an efficient contribution to the sustainable development and in the reduction of greenhouse gases emissions, the Ministry for the Environment, Land and Sea of the Republic of Italy and the Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning of the Republic of Macedonia signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) in order to maintain and enhance bilateral co-operation in the field of environment and sustainable development on the basis of equality, reciprocity and mutual benefit.

Therefore, in order to implement the Annex II to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Italian Ministry for the Environment, Land and Sea and the Macedonian Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning on "Cooperation in the field of environment and sustainable development" the Macedonian Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning issues a Call for Expression of Interest for co-financing preparation of feasibility studies and/or PDDs for the identified CDM projects in the Republic of Macedonia.

2. GOAL OF THE CALL FOR EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

The main aim of the Call of Expression of Interest is to select and co-finance the Italian and Italo-Macedonian companies that have technical and other (listed below) capacities to develop feasibility studies and/or PDDs as a first steep within the CDM development process for the following selected projects in the Republic of Macedonia:

- 1. GEOTHERMAL DISTRICT HEATING SCHEME "BANSKO":
- 2. THREE SMALL HYDRO POWER PLANTS IN MACEDONIA:
- 3.LFG RECOVERY AND FLARING AT SIX LANDFILLS BUNDLING PROJECT ACTIVITY;
- 4. ENERGY EFFICIENCY IN SILMAK THROUGH CDM PROJECT ACTIVITIES:
- 5. METHANE RECOVERY FROM MANURE HANDLING BUNDLING PROJECT ACTIVITY.

3. PROCEDURE

The Call for Expression of Interest will be conducted pursuant the procedure and the criteria set by the Joint Committee provided in the Appendix I to the Annex I to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Italian Ministry for the Environment, Land and Sea and the Macedonian Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning and in accordance with the EU legislation (EU Directive 2004/18/EC).

The Call for Expression of Interest will be issued by the Macedonian Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning through one phase procurement procedure. Applicants will be invited to express their interest in preparing feasibility study and/or PDD for a specific project/s and to respectively justify their administrative, technical and financial capacity, as well as to identify the sustainable development criteria that will be positively affected during the realization of the project. The Joint Committee will review the documentation received from the Applicants and select the companies that fulfill the conditions listed below in this document to be co-financed in the preparation of the feasibility studies and/or PDDs for the potential CDM projects in the Republic of Macedonia.

After finishing the evaluation procedure, the selected companies will stipulate a contract with the Ministry of the Environment and Physical Planning of Republic of Macedonia (Contract Authority) in order to allocate the financial assistance for the preparation of the feasibility study and/or PDD.

5. DOCUMENTS REQUIRED FOR THE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

Applicants are required to submit the complete documentation listed below. In case an incomplete documentation is submitted, the Joint Committee reserves the right to reject the Expression of Interest.

If the Applicants are applying jointly, the Lead Applicant needs to be clearly identified. In case of participation as a temporary association of companies or as a not yet formally established consortium, the legal representative of each company shall undertake, in case of selection, respectively to grant full power of legal representation to the Lead Applicant to sign the financing contract on behalf of the temporary association, or to establish the consortium.

The Applicants need to submit the listed items with the Expression of Interest:

- a. Cover letter (Attachment I)
- b. General information (Attachment II)
- c. Proof of legal existence recent extract from a Professional or Trade Register, or equivalent documentation
- d. Declaration on exclusion criteria (Attachment III)
- e. Proof of financial capacity (year-end balance sheets and profit and loss accounts for the past 3 financial years), with summary table for selected indicators over the past 3 years (Attachment IV)
- f. Reference list of key projects carried out by the Applicant (Attachment V)
- g. Resumes (EC format) of the project team members, with summary table (Attachment VI)

If applying for more than one project, the Applicant can provide a single copy of items c., d., e., f. In case of joint Applications (e.g. consortium), Applicants are required to submit - for each project, in case of application for more than one project - a single Attachment I (cover letter) and a single Attachment VI (Project team members) while supplying separate information under items b., c., d., e., f..

In the case of joint Applications, the proposed project team should be the expression of the specific expertise of the Applicants.

The Joint Committee may request the submission of additional information concerning the submitted documentation for clarification purposes.

6. SELECTION CRITERIA

Applicants will be assessed on the following criteria:

6.1 Exclusion criteria

Ineligibility

Any Applicant who is unable to fulfill the requirements as of Article 45 of Directive 2004/18/EC will be excluded from participation if he:

- a) is bankrupt or is being wound up, whose affairs are being administered by the court, who has entered into an arrangement with creditors, who has suspended business activities or who is in any analogous situation arising from a similar procedure under national laws and regulations;
- b) is the subject of proceedings for a declaration of bankruptcy, for an order for compulsory winding-up or administration by the court or for an arrangement with creditors or of any other similar proceedings under national laws or regulations;
- c) has been convicted of an offence concerning his professional conduct by a judgment which has the force of res judicata;
- d) has been guilty of grave professional misconduct proven by any means which the contracting authorities can justify;
- e) has not fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of social security contributions in accordance with the Italian legislation or legal provisions of the country in which he is established:
- f) has not fulfilled obligations relating to the payment of taxes in accordance with the Italian legislation or with the legal provisions of the country where he is established;
- g) is guilty of serious misrepresentation in supplying or failing to supply the information that may be required under this Call for Expression of Interest on the criteria for qualitative selection.

<u>Registration</u>

According Article 2 of the Annex I to the Memorandum of Understanding between the Italian Ministry for the Environment, Land and Sea and the Macedonian Ministry of Environment and Physical Planning, the Applicants, Italian and Italo-Macedonian companies, must prove enrolment in a professional or trade register in the Republic of Italy. The relevant professional and trade registers or declarations or certificates in Italy are the "Registro della Camera di commercio, industria, agricoltura e artigianato", the "Registro delle commissioni provinciali per l'artigianato" or the "Consiglio nazionale degli ordini professionali". Recent extract from such a register should therefore be submitted.

6.2 Qualitative criteria

Technical and professional capacity

The Applicant should possess proven technical and professional capacity in designing and developing CDM projects.

The technical capacity of the Applicant will be assessed by using indicators such as:

- Key expertise/core business of the Applicant/s, years of operations, permanent technical staff;
- Previous experience of the Applicant/s in similar projects;
- Professional experience of the Applicant/s in the Balkan countries;
- > Strength of proposed project team (training, professional qualifications, regional experience, years in the business).

Financial and economic standing

The financial and economic standing of the Applicant will be assessed based on, amongst others, the following indicators:

- > Net equity,
- Net assets,
- > Total sales.
- ➤ EBIT.

6.3 Additional criteria

A proven interest to invest or to raise investment in the CDM project of interest shall be positively evaluated. Such interest could be expressed e.g. in an official letter or in the Applicant's Board of Directors' minutes.

7.SUBMISSION OF THE EXPRESSION OF INTEREST - TIME SCHEDULE AND DEADLINES

The call for Expression of Interest is opened on September 22, 2008. The call for Expression of Interest will be closed on October 24, 2008.

Any Eol not being received by the Joint Committee by this given time will not be considered.
