Survey (2009)

- Sent to 18 institutions (research centres, universities, associations, arboreta, etc.)
- 43 questions (open and closed):
perceived demand for GR,
code of conduct for the acquisition of genetic material (frequency, agents)
steps taken to get to know the regulation of the country of origin

- Knowledge about the CBD, Bonn Guidelines
- Questions about the demand for the institutions' accessions:

Do they provide genetic material, to who, which countries

Existing agreements with foreign institutes or countries about genetic resources

Milestones

23 June 2011

Hungary (together with other MS) signs the Nagoya Protocol

12 February 2014

Act on the publication of the Nagoya Protocol (Act No. VIII of 2014) comes into effect

29 April 2014

Hungary deposits the ratification document
