Specific objective	The proposed initiative aims to inform and train the recipients, lower and high school students, on the importance of monitoring, the impact and repercussions that public policies have on daily life in general and, in this specific case, on the achievement of the sustainable development goals. The project has, as a general objective, to make students understand how the actions carried out at the local level contribute both individually and plurally in a decisive way to the success or failure of global objectives.	
Description of the activities	The data acquired locally, in each of the municipalities where the students reside or the schools are located, were used to carry out statistical analyzes and prepare graphical reports. With reference, for example, to SDG 6 water & sanitation, school laboratories, access to institutions and local authorities, inspections on the territory have been developed according to the following activities: - Acquire data on water consumption in the municipality of the school - Acquire data and information on the quality of the water fed into the drinking water distribution network - Acquire information and data on areas without a sewer network - Acquire data and information on the volumes of water treated by purification plants	





	Acquisition of data at the territorial level of Istat and other sources Using a spreadsheet, we proceeded to graphically represent the data, to analyze the different levels of territorial aggregation, to carry out evaluations of the temporal trend of the result indicators.	
Output	 Make students aware of the state of the environment and the influence of personal actions on the safeguarding of natural resources; Involve students in practical group activities to foster social inclusion and stimulate them on the importance of education and training;

The activities and actions of the project aim to stimulate students in "out of school" activities, in order to collect data and information on the state of the environment and the details of the SDG's themes. The laboratory activities for the verification of the progress of water theme indicators, connected to SDG6 Water 6 Sanitation, aim to develop awareness in the students in the behaviours implemented daily,





and on the repercussions of these behaviours on the environment, and on the consumption of resources. This action is consistent with the Planet area in relation to ensuring sustainable management of natural resources and, in particular "implementing the integrated management of water resources at all planning levels", and "maximizing water efficiency and adapting withdrawals to water scarcity "of the National Sustainable Development Strategy (SNSvS).
