## THE FORUM

The International Beirut Energy Forum is one of the most reputable and professional energy events in the Middle East that is specifically dedicated to sustainable energy issues and projects. IBEF is by far the biggest forum in Lebanon attracting key energy people from Lebanon, the Arab World, and the international community. The event is the main yearly platform to discuss all topics related to renewable energy, energy efficiency, and green buildings.

Held on a yearly basis since 2010, the event attracted more than 920 delegates in the seventh edition of 2016, imposing itself as the leading yearly gathering of energy professionals of the Arab World.

In 2017, The International Beirut Energy Forum will be held from 18 to 20 September 2017, and is expected to attract more than 1,000 delegates.
